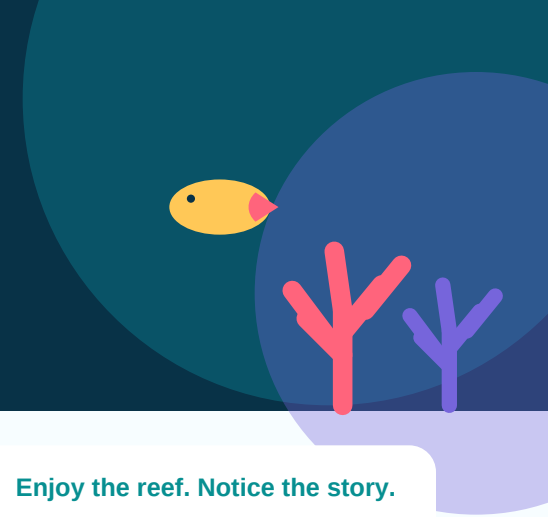


Reef Maintenance Rhythm

A friendly daily, weekly, and monthly check-in for your reef



Use what fits your aquarium, then record the results so trends are easier to see.

Enjoy the reef. Notice the story.

01 Daily

A calm 1-2 minute look

- ☐ Enjoy the view: notice fish behavior and coral extension.
- ☐ Confirm temperature, return flow, and circulation look normal.
- ☐ Check the ATO reservoir, water level, and visible leaks.
- ☐ Notice unusual sounds, salt creep, or equipment movement.

02 Weekly

Your regular maintenance rhythm

- ☐ Record the water tests used for your system and schedule.
- ☐ Complete the planned water change and observe livestock response.
- ☐ Service mechanical filtration and the skimmer as appropriate.
- ☐ Inspect pumps, powerheads, overflow, tubing, and dosing supplies.
- ☐ Photograph one coral or the full tank to preserve progress.

03 Monthly

Step back and see the pattern

- ☐ Review trends rather than judging the reef from one number.
- ☐ Rotate deeper equipment cleaning according to manufacturer guidance.
- ☐ Inspect heaters, cords, tubing, magnets, seals, and mounting points.
- ☐ Update livestock, equipment, expense, and coral-frag records.
- ☐ Plan replacement supplies and next month's maintenance focus.
